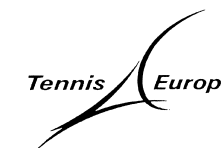

Conditions of Entry

1. The Championships are sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association and the International Tennis Federation (ITF) and will be conducted under the present Rules of Lawn Tennis and the ITF Seniors Regulations 2008. The ITF Code of Conduct will apply.
2. Competitors must have reached the minimum age for the event they have entered on or before 31 December 2008 and hold a current valid British passport.
3. The draw for all events will be made at 10.30 a.m. on Sunday 20 July 2008 at Downsview, Lower Road, South Wonston, Winchester, Hants SO21 3ER. The Committee will seed all events in accordance with LTA Tournament Regulations. **No competitor may enter for more than one singles and one doubles event.** The number of entries will be restricted and the Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
4. All competitors must send a self-addressed A5 envelope stamped for first class mail with their entry and will receive a copy of the Sunday order of play to be mailed at the end of July. Competitors not listed for Sunday should telephone the Referee [020 89712504/5] after 3.00 pm on Sunday 10 August to be advised of the date and time of their first match.
5. Any **qualifying rounds** in events which are over-subscribed will be played at the Bank of England Club, Priory Lane, Roehampton SW15 5JC. Friday 8 and Saturday 9 August.
6. In the event of adverse weather conditions it might be necessary to use other surfaces and venues.
7. Competitors must wear predominantly white clothing including shoes.
8. No complaint in connection with the Championships will be considered by the Tournament Committee unless it is made in writing and provided to the Referee within 48 hours of the occurrence causing the complaint. The decision of the Tournament Committee in all matters shall be final.
9. Competitors should take all necessary precautions to minimise his/her own risk in participating in the Championships, acknowledge that he/she enters at his/her own risk and is solely responsible for any loss, damage, personal injury or death suffered by him/her or caused to other parties as a result of any act, defect, neglect or omission by him/her. In addition, competitors undertake to indemnify the Vets Tennis GB in relation to any loss or damage suffered by the Association arising from their participation in the event.
